

Compliance Certification

Calm Act Certification

This is to certify that:

1. As required by Section 76.607 of Title 47 of the Code of Federal Regulations, all commercial advertisements embedded in the programs distributed by Shepherd's Chapel are in compliance with the loudness control practices contained in Advanced Television Systems Committee (ATSC) A/85: Recommended Practice: Techniques for Establishing and Maintaining Audio Loudness for Digital Television ("ATSC A/85 Recommended Practice") at the point of distribution by Shepherd's Chapel to authorized reception equipment of downstream multichannel video programming distributors.
